NEW SCHOOL VISITOR AND VOLUNTEER PROCEDURES! The Board of Education established visitor procedures to reduce disruptions that might interfere with the educational program or threaten the safety of students and staff at St. John Lutheran School. A school visitor shall not be permitted to visit any student who is not his/her child, unless permission for such a visit is granted in advance by that student's parent/guardian. Pre-school children and students from other schools shall not be permitted to visit school while classes are in session, unless special permission is granted in advance by the school principal. If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to contact Mr. Eternick or one of the Board of Education members at your earliest convenience. Please see the following procedures for visitors and volunteers:

- ◆ **Visitors:** (this includes parents) When entering the school building between 8am - 3:05pm on a school day, except when attending scheduled school programs that occur during the regular school day i.e. parent visitation, school musical, Christmas concert, etc.:
 - Please stop by the office to sign in and pick up a "Visitor" pass to wear while you're visiting school.
 - When you leave, you will need to stop by the office and sign out and drop off your pass.
- ◆ **Volunteers:**
 - When you arrive at school, please stop by the office and pick up a "Volunteer" pass to wear while you are volunteering in the school.
 - When you leave, please stop by the office and drop off your pass.
