CRISIS RESPONSE PLAN DRILL

- ◆ The State of Wisconsin requires every school to have a "Crisis Response Plan" in place.
- ◆ In accordance with this state law, we are also required to hold drills practicing the procedures of the plan.
- ◆ If your child comes home saying there was an intruder in school, please realize we were running such a drill.
- ◆ Since we are required to run a number of these drills each year, we may be doing this a few more times before the end of the school year.

EIGHTH GRADE PARENTS

- ◆ Lakeside Lutheran High School is part of the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP).
- ◆ For students selected by the state, families receive a voucher that pays their students' Lakeside tuition in full.
- ◆ The open application period for the statewide Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) for the 2019-2020 school year begins February 1 and runs through April 20, 2019.
- ◆ Students entering 9th grade and those transferring from a public high school at any grade level are eligible for this.
- ◆ There are a total of 77 participating students in the 2018-19 school year. Lakeside's General Board has approved 128 seats for the 2019-20 school year. This number reflects a sufficient number of seats for Lakeside students currently in the program with the remainder for new choice students in all grades.
- ◆ The Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP) online parent application is available February 1st at dpi.wi.gov/choice.
